Report of one week Management Development Program 17th October 2022 to 21st October 2022



The Central Institute of Business Management Research and Development, Nagpur, in collaboration with the Government of India's Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises MSME-Development Institute, Nagpur, hosted a Management Development Program on Financial Management from October 17 through October 21, 2022.
