The meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was held under the chairmanship of the Director. The following agenda items were discussed and resolved.

Agenda 1: Confirmation of Minutes of the Previous Meeting

The minutes of the previous IQAC meeting held on 1st July 2025 were placed before the members for confirmation.

Resolution No. 1:

Resolved that the minutes of the previous IQAC meeting held on 1st July 2025 be and are hereby confirmed and approved unanimously by all the members present.

Agenda 2: Review of Institutional Website and Social Media Outreach Activities

Resolution No. 2:

The IQAC reviewed the functioning and content management of the institutional website and social media platforms. Members suggested that the website be further strengthened through timely updates of accreditation-related information, research publications, patents, MoUs, and institutional best practices. It was also resolved to enhance the institution's digital presence by increasing engagement on social media platforms through systematic posting of events, success stories, outreach activities, and student-centric initiatives.

Agenda 3: Planning for National Conference (CIMC), Seminars, Workshops, and Student Development Activities

Resolution No. 3: The committee reviewed the academic calendar and deliberated on the conduct of various academic and professional development activities during the academic session. It was resolved that departments shall organize Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs), seminars, workshops, and expert sessions focusing on emerging areas such as management innovation, entrepreneurship, sustainability, digital transformation, and research excellence.

The IQAC further reviewed the preparation of Central India Management Conclave (International Conference) scheduled on 10th April 2026.

The committee also resolved to host the AIMS Regional Round Table Meet in collaboration with the Vidarbha Management Association to facilitate dialogue among academicians, industry experts, and management professionals.

For student development, it was decided to organize a Workshop on Research Methodology to enhance students' research aptitude and analytical skills. The committee also approved the conduct of the intercollegiate mega event "Astralogy", comprising academic, cultural, and sports competitions aimed at promoting holistic development and inter-institutional engagement.

To foster innovation and entrepreneurship among students, the committee approved workshops on entrepreneurship development, visits to industries, incubation centres, and innovation hubs. Further, to enhance students' employability skills and career preparedness, it was resolved to conduct psychometric assessments. Based on the assessment outcomes, students will be provided with personalized career guidance and mentoring support.

Agenda 4: Review of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Awareness Programmes and Patent Filing Initiatives

Resolution No. 4:

The IQAC reviewed the initiatives undertaken to create awareness about Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) among faculty members and students. Members emphasized the need for conducting additional workshops, expert lectures, and training programmes on patents, copyrights, trademarks, and research commercialization. Faculty members were encouraged to identify innovative research outcomes and pursue patent filing with institutional guidance and support.

Agenda 5: Review of Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) and Action Taken Report

Resolution No. 5:


The IQAC reviewed the findings of the Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) conducted during the academic year. The survey reflected overall satisfaction among students regarding the teaching-learning process, institutional infrastructure, student support services, and academic environment.


The committee discussed suggestions received from students concerning enhancement of digital learning resources, industry interaction, career guidance initiatives, and extracurricular activities. The Action Taken Report on the feedback received was reviewed and appreciated. It was resolved to continue implementing quality enhancement measures based on student feedback and to monitor their effectiveness through periodic review mechanisms.

The Chairperson informed the members about the progress of various quality assurance initiatives undertaken by the institution and emphasized the need for continuous improvement in academic and administrative processes. No other matter was raised for discussion.
